# Call to Action for Shipping Decarbonization Information Session

**28 JULY AT 16:00–17:00 PM HKT**

The Getting to Zero Coalition and the Hong Kong Shipowners Association are pleased to invite you to attend an information session webinar to present the COP26 Call to Action for Shipping Decarbonization. The webinar will take place on 28 July at 16:00–17:00 HKT.

The Call to Action for Shipping Decarbonization was developed by a multi-stakeholder taskforce, convened by the [Getting to Zero Coalition](#) with members from the entire maritime ecosystem including shipping, chartering, finance, ports and fuel production.

The purpose of the Call to Action for Shipping Decarbonization is to demonstrate the leadership of maritime industry stakeholders and their desire to work with governments and other stakeholders to make it possible to decarbonize the maritime industry by 2050 in line with the Paris Climate Agreement.

The main messages of the Call to Action are:

- Shipping must align with the Paris Agreement temperature goal and fully decarbonize using net-zero energy sources by 2050.
- The signatories to the call to action firmly believe an urgent and equitable decarbonization of the maritime supply chain by 2050 is possible and necessary.
- The private sector is leading the way and taking concrete actions to make zero emission vessels and fuels the default choice by 2030, and decisive government action and enabling policy frameworks are needed now to reach our 2030 and 2050 ambitions.

The Call to Action will be launched ahead of COP26 to send a message to governments about the urgency of shipping decarbonization. Companies from across the global maritime ecosystem are invited to become signatories to the Call to Action to increase its impact.

This information session will comprise a presentation of the Call to Action as well as the process of becoming a signatory. There will also be an opportunity for participants to ask questions about anything related to the Call to Action, whether content or process.
