Co-organised with the Maritime and Coastguard Agency and UK Shipping Concierge, the British Consulate-General Hong Kong is pleased to invite maritime stakeholders to a breakfast presentation delivered by the Director of UK Customer Maritime Services, Lars Lippuner. It will be an opportunity to explore how modernising seafarer training can bring significant benefits to the industry and shipping companies.

Since December 2021, the UK has been actively working with stakeholders and industry to modernise seafarer training. This effort has led to updated training content and assessments for all seafarers' courses leading to a UK STCW Certificate of Competency (CoC), incorporating new training aligned with onboard technological advancements and alternative fuels.

Starting September 2025, these key changes will be implemented in all UK colleges,
