In view of the fact that, starting from November 10, 2025, the United States has suspended for one year the implementation of its Section 301 measures against China's maritime, logistics, and shipbuilding industries, the Ministry of Commerce hereby issues the *Decision on Suspending the Implementation of Countermeasures Against Five U.S.-Related Subsidiaries of Hanwha Ocean Co., Ltd. for One Year*, effective as of November 10, 2025.

Decision on Suspending the Implementation of Countermeasures Against Five U.S.-Related Subsidiaries of Hanwha Ocean Co., Ltd. for One Year

At Eastern Standard Time, November 9, 2025, the United States announced the suspension, effective November 10, of its Section 301 measures concerning China's maritime, logistics, and shipbuilding industries for a period of one year.

Accordingly, pursuant to the Anti-Foreign Sanctions Law of the People's Republic of China and the Provisions on the Implementation of the Anti-Foreign Sanctions Law of the People's Republic of China, the Chinese side has decided that, starting from Beijing time November 10, 2025, the relevant countermeasures stipulated in Order No. 6 (2025) of the Ministry of Commerce—Decision on Taking Countermeasures Against Five U.S.-Related Subsidiaries of Hanwha Ocean Co., Ltd.—shall be suspended for one year.
